Rules for Dairy & Beef Cattle:

1. The age of all cow classes will be computed as Sept 1st preceding the Fair.
2. Exhibitor must be prepared to present certificates of registry for all cattle to the superintendent 48 hours prior to show starting time. No animal will be exhibited for premium without said paperwork completed on registration, transfer certificate or pedigree papers. Superintendent may check all certificates and identify with individual animals.
3. Horns-cattle shall be polled or properly dehorned except calf months or younger, unless required by Breed Assoc. to have horns intact.
4. Exhibitors will be limited to 1 entry in group classes. All animals in group classes must be owned by 1 exhibitor. Exhibitor allowed 2 entries in individual classes
5. Animals shown in group classes must be shown in individual classes.
6. No milk will be accepted for Grade A milk sale through the Fair unless it has been milked in the Fair's milking parlor.
7. NO BULL shall be allowed to enter the grounds or remain thereon, without being safely secured, a person in charge of managing it, and if over 1 yr old, without a substantial ring in its nose. All bulls must be confined to the barns unless being led for judging.

RULES:

1. Goats must be owned by exhibitor and have been in his/her possession by July 1 of the current year.
2. All open class dairy goats must be dehorned or naturally polled. All non-dairy goats may be exhibited with horns.
3. No buck will be permitted of any age
4. All goats 6 weeks of age & older must be tied at the fair – except Angora goats
5. Exhibitors will be allowed only 1 entry in group classes: Dam & Daughter
6. Exhibitors will be allowed 2 entries in individual classes.
7. Milking on show day is left at the discretion of the exhibitor.

4. Exhibitors acknowledge that Vegetables & Fruits are judged on cleanliness, uniformity and market size; and that judges reserve the right to withhold placing from produce that does not meet their desired standards.
5. Exhibitors acknowledge that ANY produce that is too spoiled for display will be disposed of as needed before the end of Fair.
